

GENERAL NOTICE 1

First Aid If In Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. If eye irritation persists, get medical advice/attention. If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. GENERAL NOTICE 2

General Information 8Ball is a drift reduction and water conditioning agent formulated specifically for XtendiMax(R) tank mixes to reduce off-target drift. 8Ball imparts a neutral pH. 8Ball can eliminate antagonism of the spray tank caused by hard water minerals such as calcium, iron and magnesium. The surfactant ingredient in 8Ball improves spray droplet spreading and penetration into the targeted leaf surface. 8Ball provides humectancy to spray droplets resulting in a slower drying time for enhanced uptake of active ingredients. 8Ball can be used for a wide range of pesticide and nutrient spray mixtures when accompanying labels recommend water conditioners and spreader-wetter adjuvants.
