FIRST AID

Always call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If On Skin Or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of soap and water for 15 to 20 minutes. If skin irritation occurs, get medical advice/attention.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Assault is a highly active methylated seed oil and surfactant blend adjuvant that delivers superior wetting, spreading and leaf cuticle penetration characteristics. Assault may be used with pesticide products containing label instructions recommending use of methylated seed oils or high surfactant oil adjuvants.

Assault improves herbicide efficacy by modifying the wetting and deposition characteristics of the spray solution resulting in a more even and uniform spray deposit.

Assault enhanced surfactant content allows lower use rates than standard oil activator spray adjuvants. Care must be taken when treating sensitive crops, particularly during periods of drought stress, high temperatures and high humidity.

MIXING

Prior to pesticide application, clean mixing and application equipment according to pesticide label directions. To minimize foaming fill spray tank 2/3 full of water and begin agitation. If foaming is anticipated the addition of an antifoaming agent should be added before pesticides, nutrients, or Assault.

Unless instructed otherwise by pesticide label, add pesticides and/or fertilizers in the following sequence: 1) Micronutrients and fertilizers; 2) Dry flowables and dispersible granules; 3) Flowables; 4) Water soluble pesticides; 5) Emulsifiable concentrates. Continue agitation and add MSO H-Surf, when completed, reduce agitation and allow to mix for 1 to 2 minutes. While under minimal agitation, continue filling tank and allow to mix for 10 to 15 minutes prior to application.

NOTE: For optimum results, spray mixes containing Assault should be applied within 36 hours.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Always read and follow directions on the label of the pesticide being used with this product.

Ground, Aerial, Low Volume, CDA: Use Assault at a rate of 4 to 6 pints per 100 gallons of spray solution, or 0.50% to 0.75% v/v.

Difficult To Control Weed Populations: Use Assault at 8 pints per 100 gallons (1.0% v/v). Do not exceed the accompanying pesticide label recommendation for tank mix adjuvants.

Note: If pesticide label recommendations are void of information for use of this product, the user should consult local agricultural resources, have prior experience using this adjuvant, or conduct limited test spray applications to determine most effective use rate for Assault.
