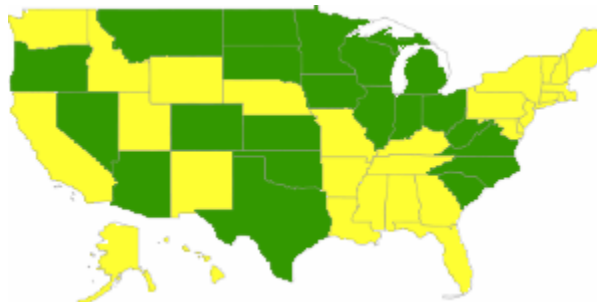

GENERAL NOTICE 2

General Information H2O Conditioner contains a deposition agent, formulated to enhance spray coverage and retention of pesticide products, that recommend the use of ammonium sulfate or a nitrogen source. H2O Conditioner improves efficacy of various pesticide sprays by minimizing antagonism caused by hard water metal ions that are generally present in most spray water sources. The humectant ingredient in H2O Conditioner slows the drying time of spray droplets and minimizes crystal formation of pesticide residues that can impede plant uptake. The acidifying agents in H2O Conditioner modify spray water pH. The antifoam ingredient in H2O Conditioner minimizes formation of troublesome foam.
