FIRST AID

GENERAL INFORMATION

Crop Oil Concentrate is a blend of highly refined spray oil with nonionic surfactants for use with a range of pesticides or fertilizer products.

Crop Oil Concentrate can positively affect pesticide spray application and pesticide efficacy by modifying the wetting and deposition characteristics of the spray solution.

Optimum pesticide or fertilizer performance results can be influenced by the crop, spray equipment, spray volume, pressure, droplet size, spray tank mixture and environmental factors.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Not for aquatic use. Do not contaminate water sources by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastewaters.

HAZARD STATEMENTS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read and follow the precautions and directions for use on this label and the pesticide it is being applied with.

MIXING: Fill spray tank 2/3 full, add the desired amount of herbicide and continue filling. Add Crop Oil Concentrate last. After filling, continue agitation, unless instructed otherwise by pesticide label. Always follow pesticide label directions, acceptable practices and advice from your crop consultant.

Crop Oil Concentrate may be applied by ground, CDA or aerial equipment. Use Crop Oil Concentrate to allow uniform wetting and deposition.

Ground, Aerial, Low Volume CDA: Use 4 to 8 pints per 100 gallons of spray solution or 0.50% to 1.00% v/v concentration.

NOTE: The above application rate recommendations are considered effective for most uses. Some pesticide label instructions may require higher rates. Always follow the pesticide label instructions and conduct a phytotoxicity trial for use of this product when the pesticide or fertilizer label is void of any information regarding use of a crop oil adjuvant.
