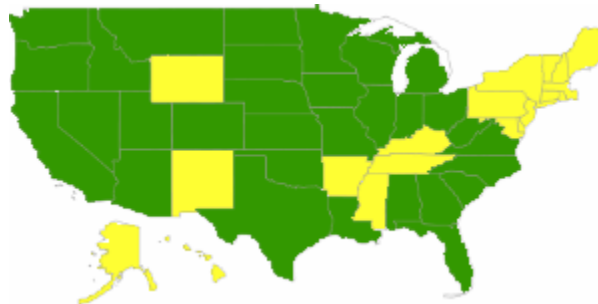

**GENERAL NOTICE 1**

**GENERAL NOTICE 2**

General Information Trail Blazer is a unique low use-rate adjuvant that replaces crop oil and modified oil adjuvants. Trail Blazer provides the efficacy of an oil adjuvant with the crop safety of a nonionic surfactant. Trail Blazer is designed for use with herbicides, fungicides, insecticides, defoliant, desiccants, plant growth regulators and any other crop protection product that recommends the use of an oil concentrate or nonionic surfactant. Trail Blazer reduces spray application wash-off caused by rainfall, dew or irrigation. Trail Blazer is an effective single-use adjuvant for tank mixtures that contain multiple crop protection products that recommend oil and/or nonionic surfactant additives. Trail Blazer contains an integrated antifoaming system that helps minimize foam in the spray tank.

Directions For Use Trail Blazer is intended for use with products registered for agricultural, horticultural, turf, ornamental, industrial, aquatic and non-crop uses. Read and follow all pesticide label directions. Do not use where the pesticide label specifically prohibits the use of an adjuvant. If the pesticide label neither recommends nor prohibits an adjuvant, the applicator must have previous experience with the adjuvant/pesticide spray mixture or should apply a small test area before making large scale applications. Ground Application: For pesticides where an oil concentrate is recommended: 1 to 3 pints per 100 gallons of spray solution. Air Application: For pesticides where an oil concentrate is recommended: 4 to 8 ounces per acre. Refer to pesticide label for minimum water volume per acre. Aquatic Application: For pesticides where an oil concentrate is recommended: 2 to 4 pints per 100 gallons of spray solution.
